The Project's Progress

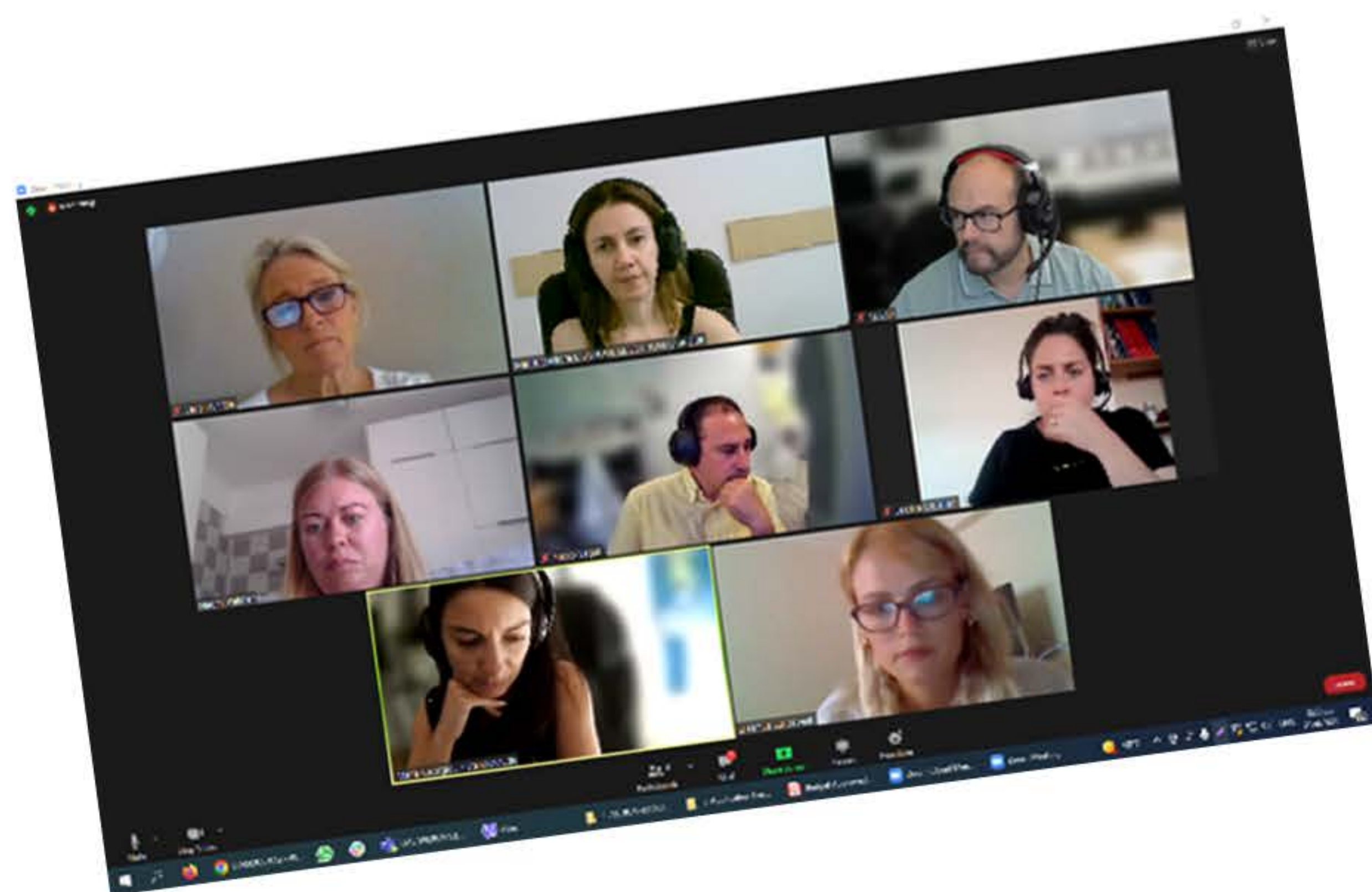
IO1: The Desk Research comparing traditional approaches and augmented reality in language acquisition in each partner country, is completed and is also available on the project's website.
